

Student Poster Contest Rules/Entry Form



1. The poster must be original artwork.
2. The poster must illustrate the importance of trees. The words 'Trees Are Important' **must** be a part of the poster.
3. The artist's first and last name must appear on the lower right hand corner of the poster.
4. Entries must be on 12"x18" paper.
5. Artist must allow the poster to be used for publication.
6. Any artistic medium may be used, such as markers, crayons, paint pens, watercolor, ink, acrylic and colored pencils.
7. Collages are not acceptable. DO NOT GLUE any items onto your poster.
8. Computer or photo-generated art or printing is not acceptable.
9. Posters must not be matted, mounted, laminated, framed or folded.
10. Posters must be delivered to the **West Seneca Senior Center** at 4620 Seneca Street, West Seneca on Saturday, May 20 from 1 to 4pm **or** on Tuesday, May 23 from 6 to 8pm.
11. Only one poster entry per person.
12. Decisions of the judges are final. (Judges criteria includes clarity of theme, visual effectiveness, originality, and universal appeal)
13. **Poster must be picked up at 4pm on June 4, 2017 or it will become the property of the BNAC.**
